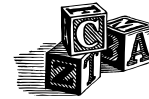

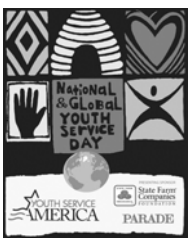

Phase II Update

Revised Design: The new design for the garden can be found on the reverse. Grateful thanks to **Serge and Robin Young** for their time and talents. This will be our starting point as we progress with installing the stepping stones, pavers and other landscaping elements in April – May.

April 1 – April 28: Site Prep – fill & topsoil; install boulders, stepping stones; paving stones. All of this will be accomplished by both volunteers (masons, gardeners) and the City of Beacon Highway and Parks Department (laborers and heavy equipment).



Planting will be kicked off by **Brownie Scout Troop #313’s Service Learning Project on April 22 & 29**. This group of energetic 7 and 8 year old girls has been learning about what it takes to plan a garden, and a project of this scope. They will help in selection of one tree and several perennials, as well as be involved

in maintenance of the playpark and other playgrounds in Beacon. Their project is being supported by a Youth Service America “Minnie” Grant sponsored by Disney, and is part of **National & Global Youth Service Day, April 20 – 22**. May 5, 2007: “Ree-Play” Fundraiser to benefit garden, shade structure.

May, 2007: Re-install two benches; install log circle; install crane sculpture; continue planting; re-install fence.

June, 2007: Install temporary shade structure over sandbox; begin garden maintenance schedule; continue planting as necessary. Brownie Troop #313 Celebration in the Garden.

September, 2007: Finalize shade structure design.

December, 2007: Deadline for shade structure grant through the American Academy of Dermatology.
