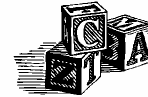

Stepping Stones: It is still not too late to get yours in, or to purchase a kit. E-mail kelly@weeplayproject.org if you are interested. One sad note - The winter was hard on some of the stones, so make a point to stop by and check on yours – we are going to try to replace the ones that seem to be falling apart, or come up with another solution – your suggestions would be welcome!

Needed: Log Chunks! We are looking for large chunks of logs from freshly cut large trees for seating. If you are cutting down a tree, or know someone that is, we would be happy to take some of it off your hands. We need about 30 sections of logs that measure approximately 2 – 3 feet in diameter, and about 2 ½ feet tall. The plan is to shape them, seal them and then create a log circle in one part of the

garden for a story-time circle; we would also like to surround the perimeter of the sandbox with the chunks – partly to give the parents a place to sit, and to help discourage the children from bringing the sand out to the playbouncer surface.
